The WLCSC sponsors two summer bands for students in Elementary and Junior High School. The **Scarlet Band** is comprised of students who have completed at least two years of band. The **Grey Band** serves the students who just completed their first year of playing or students who would like to learn a secondary instrument. Summer band rehearsals will begin on Wednesday, May 29th and will be every Monday through Friday through June 25th. All rehearsals take place in the high school band room and there will be a concert on Tuesday, June 25th to showcase both of the bands, as well as the orchestras which will be held in the West Lafayette gymnasium. The Scarlet Band will rehearse from 9:30-11:00 and the Grey Band from 11:00-12:30. The fee for participation in summer band is \$100 per student. This covers the purchase of music and the salaries of the directors. You also must return the form attached below with the fee by Friday, May 17th.** A student is not officially registered for the summer band program until the online form is completed and the payment is received.
